Carry-On Allowance:

- Economy Class: **1 carry-on bag** plus **1 personal item** (handbag or laptop bag)
- Business and First Class: Increased allowance with additional personal items

Checked Baggage:

- Economy Class: 1–2 checked bags depending on route and fare class
- Business/First Class: 2–3 checked bags, weight limits vary (up to 32 kg per bag)

Special Items:

- Musical instruments, sports equipment, and oversized luggage may require additional fees or prior notification

Pro Tip: Always check your specific ticket type to confirm baggage allowances before traveling.
