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Vicodin is a brand name for a combination prescription medication used to relieve moderate to moderately severe pain.

Key Facts About Vicodin

Feature	Description
Active Ingredients	Hydrocodone (an opioid analgesic/narcotic) and Acetaminophen (a non-opioid pain reliever and fever reducer).
Primary Use	Relief of moderate to moderately severe pain .
Drug Class	Opioid/Non-opioid analgesic combination.
Controlled Substance	Vicodin and its generic equivalents (Hydrocodone/Acetaminophen) are typically classified as a Schedule II controlled substance in the United States due to the high potential for abuse and severe dependence (psychological and physical).

Important Warnings

- **Abuse and Dependence:** Hydrocodone is an opioid and has a high potential for **abuse, misuse, and addiction**, which can lead to overdose and death.
- **Respiratory Depression:** Opioids can cause serious or life-threatening **slowed or stopped breathing**, especially when starting the medication or increasing the dose.
- **Liver Damage (Hepatotoxicity):** The acetaminophen component can cause **acute liver failure**, which can be fatal, especially if taken in high doses, by individuals with underlying liver disease, or with alcohol. Prescription products containing acetaminophen now typically have a maximum of 325 mg per dosage unit.
- **Interactions:** It should be used with extreme caution with other Central Nervous System (CNS) depressants, such as alcohol, benzodiazepines, and other sedatives, as this combination can increase the risk of severe sedation, respiratory depression, coma, and death.

Common Side Effects

Common side effects often include:

- Drowsiness or sleepiness
- Dizziness or lightheadedness
- Nausea and vomiting
- Constipation
- Stomach pain
- Fuzzy thinking

Note on Vicodin Availability

While "Vicodin" is a well-known brand name, some specific formulations have been discontinued in the U.S. market. However, its generic equivalent, **hydrocodone/acetaminophen**, is widely available and used.
