Important warnings and interactions

- Avoid alcohol and other sedatives while taking Tramadol; mixing can dangerously slow breathing.
- Some antidepressants and other medicines can interact with Tramadol and raise seizure risk or cause a condition called serotonin syndrome.
- Tell your clinician about any history of seizures, head injury, or substance use disorder.
- Not for use in children under certain ages or in patients with specific health conditions without specialist oversight.

Your clinician will adjust treatment if there are interaction risks or specific health concerns.

Dependence, tolerance, and safe use

- Tramadol can cause physical dependence if used for a long time or at high doses.
- Tolerance may develop, meaning higher doses are needed for the same effect; only a clinician should change dose.
- If stopping Tramadol after longer use, follow a taper plan from your clinician to reduce withdrawal symptoms.

Safe storage and handling

Always keep emergency contact numbers for your clinician and pharmacist handy.

Monitoring and follow-up with subscription services
